Richard Little came to work for Lorenz Implement Clinton, Ok in May of 1959 at the age of 19 years old to begin his life as one of the best mechanics to ever work on John Deere equipment. Richard had the privilege of working for three generations of the Lorenz Family, Otto, Don, and Robert (Bob). Richard started with Lorenz Implement, which became Lorenz Inc and now has become Western Equipment, he dedicated his life not only to this company but also to the farmers of Western Oklahoma. Vickie often said that Richard had another woman in his life and it was Western Equipment, he loved his job and this company.. Richard worked as a Mechanic/Service Technician up until January 1 2016, when he decided that the world of electronics had out grown him, he then transferred up to the parts counter to continue to serve customers. Richard could take a 4020 or a 7720 combine apart clear down to the frame and could put them back together with his eyes closed, I swear the man knew every part on that generation of equipment.. Richard had a goal to work 60 years for this great company, but was cut short by approximately seven months due to cancer, Richard passed away on October 20 2018.
